Hi John,

Kathy forwarded your email to me. I will answer your questions in the order in which you write them.

1. Every town in York County is receiving their own allocation. The ~40mm is allocated directly to the County. South Berwick is receiving \$754,215.
2. The county Commissioners will receive any type of proposal that is submitted to them. However, it does not mean that they will select it for funding.
3. The commissioners have made a general statement that they are interested in funding projects that provide the biggest benefit for the entire county
4. The commissioners have not determined the various allocation(s) to be set aside to fund the various allowed activity(s) under the ARP. The commissioners may choose to fund a single project.
5. I would suggest you submit a proposal outlining a general description and general estimates. I do not believe there is a need for an overly detailed proposal at this point in time. I suspect the commissioners will be reviewing projects in greater detail during the month of July
6. No caps have been discussed yet

The purpose of tomorrow's meeting is to solicit feedback from government entities, non profits and the public at-large. The commissioners intend to conduct an additional public hearing the following week. I expect during their meeting in July they will develop broad categories of projects based on the feedback received and begin to decide how to move forward and what type(s) of project(s) they want to fund. We are not making any guarantees at this point.

I have a couple of questions ahead of tomorrow's ARP funding meeting.

Of the \$40.3 million, how much is going directly to the Town's with in York County? Or is the \$40.3 million above and beyond what the Town's will be getting?

One of the components of the ARP funding is investment in water and wastewater infrastructure. Will the County Commissioners accept and fund proposals for projects from individual water utilities with in York County?

Or a project that would benefit more than one water utility?

How much money out of the \$40.3 million will be set aside for water and wastewater projects in York County?

How soon will projects need to be submitted for consideration?

Is there a cap on funds for any one project?

Thank you for your time in getting answers to these questions and I look forward to hearing back from you.
