All cases on the following page(s) are set for trial on the dates stated above and are subject to the following conditions:

1. All counsel, parties and witnesses must be at court, ready to proceed to trial on any and all dates assigned for the case. You can expect your case to be assigned more than one trial date. You may not be considered released from your assigned date(s) until you have received specific permission from the court to be released.
2. All counsel and unrepresented parties shall regularly contact CAROL J. LOVEJOY at (207) 324-1577 to find out the status of their cases, and to inform the court should their case settle.
3. All correspondence should be mailed to the **York County Probate Court**. The correspondence needs to have the Docket Number, which is listed beside the case on the attached list.

****PROCEDURE FOR SCHEDULING CASES****

4. Cases on the trailing docket are scheduled as follows: After the deadline for the Request for Protections has passed, the Register will assign the cases for trial based upon the Request for Protections filed with the Court. Parties should not assume that all requests would be granted. The Register will then send out a second list to all counsel and unrepresented parties. The second list will clearly state the days each case is set for trial/hearing in an additional column, to the right of the case number. Please be sure you review the dates listed on second list carefully, as this document is your only notice of the days you will need to appear for your hearing.

**NO CONTINUANCE OR PROTECTION WILL BE
GRANTED UNLESS:**

1. CONTINUANCE. The Court will not consider a request for continuance off this month's trailing docket unless it is made by **written motion**, stating the reason(s) for the continuance, when the reason(s) became known **and** whether any party has an objection to the motion. Counsel and unrepresented parties have an obligation to inquire of opposing parties whether they have any objection.

2. PROTECTION. The Court will not consider a request for protection unless it is **presented in writing and states the reason(s) and the specific date(s)** for which protection is requested. **The reasons(s) for the request for protection should be specific, including (if applicable) the specific nature of the other proceeding(s) in conflict with the York County Probate Trailing Docket case (e.g., another previously scheduled trial, pretrial conference, motion hearing, etc.), the actual times and courts the other matter(s) are scheduled to take place, and the compelling reason(s) why those other matter(s) should take precedence over your York County Probate Court Trailing Docket case.** Counsel and parties should not assume that all requests for protection would be accommodated. Moreover, cases on the trailing docket take precedence over most other conflicts, such as conference, mediation sessions and hearings.

3. FILING DEADLINE. A motion for continuance must be filed immediately after the reason(s) become(s) known. **A REQUEST FOR PROTECTION** must be filed in York County Probate Court **NO LATER THAN 4:30 P.M. ON OCTOBER 26, 2017** unless an actual emergency or other cause prevents a timely filing. A copy must be sent to all opposing counsel, unrepresented parties, and (if applicable) the guardian *ad litem*.

4. NOTIFICATION. Counsel and unrepresented parties shall notify the Court of settlement without delay, by contacting CAROL J. LOVEJOY, REGISTER at (207) 324-1577.

IMPORTANT WARNING:

You have the right to appear and be heard at all court events (trial, hearing, conference). If you fail to appear at any or all court events without good cause, action may be taken on your case even though you are not there. This means that the Court may, in your absence, enter an interim/temporary order, OR hold a final hearing and enter a final default order or judgment regarding any and all of the issues in your case. The Court also has the option to dismiss any pleading that you have filed if you do not show up.
